

Appendix B: Uniform – Shoes

As part of our uniform policy, students are required to wear **fully enclosed black shoes**. These may be of a formal or sports style and can be constructed from leather or synthetic materials, but **must not have any coloured logos, decals or markings**.



To ensure compliance with the Tasmanian Department of Education’s and Penguin District school’s uniform policies, student footwear is to ...

- comply with Education Department and Workplace Health and Safety requirements
- enable maximum structural support for growing feet
- enable safe participation in classrooms, the playground and in specialist subjects.

Slipper styles, slip-ons, coloured laces, and ballet type shoes are not acceptable uniform items.
